Review: Can you name all of the 6 parts of the armor of God?

What are those 6 parts “empty” without?

I. Paul Described Himself as an AMBASSADOR (**Ephesians 6:19-20**)

A. An ambassador is the highest ranking diplomat who represents a NATION in another nation’s territory

B. Paul felt that this was the best DESCRIPTION of who he was because...

1. he went and spoke with **BOLDNESS** knowing the message would be “given to him”
***I Peter 3:15 & Exodus 4:11-12**

2. he went and spoke with boldness because he loved the GOSPEL

II. Paul was an Ambassador “IN CHAINS”

A. Not even being physically chained could stop him

B. Paul didn’t make EXCUSES

III. What About Me?

A. YOU, a part of God’s redemption plan

*God chooses YOU to be the incarnate representation of Christ

B. You are STRATEGICALLY stationed as an ambassador

*He has given you a large mission field in your school and family where you can be a light

*You are where the harvest is most ripe...don’t miss the opportunity

*64% of Christians accepted Christ by 18 years old

*highest % came to Christ because of a friend; only 10% because of a pastor/YP

2 Corinthians 4: 1-6 ~ Therefore, since we have this ministry because we were shown mercy, we do not give up. Instead, we have renounced shameful secret things, not walking in deceit or distorting God's message, but commending ourselves to every person's conscience in God's sight by an open display of the truth. But if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing. In their case, the god of this age has blinded the minds of the unbelievers so they cannot see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. For we are not proclaiming ourselves but Jesus Christ as Lord, and ourselves as your slaves because of Jesus. For God who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of God's glory in the face of Jesus Christ.
